

SOY CHALLENGE YIELDS REAL RESULTS



NK was a clear winner at this year's Ontario Soybean Growers' Soybean Yield Challenge. Though their management approach varied widely, all three winning producers used NK varieties to generate exceptional yields.

ZONE 1 WINNER

Dan Shantz grew NK S03-W4, a food-grade variety, on his Petersburg-area plot, producing **69.1 bushels** despite unseasonably cold temperatures in the weeks after planting.

ZONE 2 WINNER

John Denys produced a yield of **70.2 bushels** on his plot in the Parkhill area, using NK's non-GMO IP variety S20-G7. He's been growing IP soybeans since they first came on the market. This year, he says, "It was simply a matter of mother nature and the beans coming together at the same time."

ZONE 3 WINNER

Casey Klaver was "impressed" with the NK RR-type beans he planted and praised the "nice lush crop" that produced the highest yield of all three winners at **72.1 bushels**.

Some 40 growers entered the first annual challenge, which OSG chairman Leo Guilbeault hopes will "raise awareness of the factors affecting soybean yields."
